

HASTINGS YMCA COMPANY MINI-GOLF TOURNAMENT

SPORTSMANSHIP

- Team captains are directly responsible for team members before, during, & after each round of mini golf.
- If a team or participant on a team is caught cheating (lying on the scorecard), the team will immediately be disqualified.
- Any trash talking or taunting which is intended to embarrass, ridicule, or demean others under any circumstance will not be tolerated. First offence is a warning; the second offense is ejection from the league.

EQUIPMENT:

· The YMCA provides putters and golf balls. Golfers may bring own putter and golf ball if so choosing.

PLAYERS:

- All participants must sign the team roster before golfing. Teams may golf with less than 4 and more than 4. Only 4 scores will be counted.
- If playing with more than 4 golfers, captains should highlight which 4 golfers will count toward the team score.

LEAGUE PLAY:

- Teams will golf 18 holes.
- It is at the discretion of the teams when they golf between the time of 11:30 am 2:30 pm. All team members must golf together.
- Every team member will golf every hole.
- Captains should record the score for each team member (including self) for every hole on a scorecard.
- After each hole and scores have been recorded, circle the lowest score (this will be used for the team total).
- After golfing, captains should return scorecard to the golf shack so YMCA staff can update leaderboard on outside of golf shack.
- If a ball gets lodged, stuck, or stops along the concrete, golfers may move the ball a putter's head length away from the concrete. Please be respectful and honest with this rule.
- If a ball goes out of bounds, +1 should be added to the hole score and the ball should be placed back on the course where it went out of play.
